The attached list is transcribed from a list was found among my ancestor William Vance Hays' papers. Unfortunately there was no date on the document. Based on a report in the Pittsburgh Daily Gazette (Monday, 28 July 1873), I believe this fire occurred on 26 July 1873. There it states:

"....On Saturday, Samuel, Benjamin, Levi and Elizabeth Eyers were committed to jail by Alderman McMasters. They are charged by George W. Jardine of North Fayette township, with firing his dwelling."

"We the undersigned, believing mutual protection to be a duty and sympathizing with the Jardine family of North Star. Who have lost their Dwelling house, Storehouse & Granary with all their contents by fire believed to be the work of an Incendiary. We agree to pay the sums annexed to our names as soon as convenient."
